Profile Summary

I have a PhD in Communication and four Masters in the disciplines of Journalism & Communication, English Literature, Sociology and Business Administration. I have over 37 years of experience working in media and management roles in both public and private sector undertakings. I have offered my professional expertise to five English-language daily newspapers as mainstream journalist (including as Editor of Free Press, Journal, Indore). I have also served as the Chief of Public Relations & Communication and as the Media Advisor at the Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL), the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and the Planning Commission of India, respectively. Since the last decade, I have been involved in establishing and managing a group of educational institutions with the eventual goal of fostering a holistic education in the field of Mass Communication and Liberal Arts for the deprived section of society, especially the first generation learners and working passionately for the Community College movement in India. During the last one decade, we have been able to train and place hundreds of rural students in the newspapers, television channels, radio stations, PR and Advertising Agencies.

I had the experience of visiting ten community colleges in the United States of America as a Fulbright Scholar in 2014. In 2015, I had the opportunity to visit another 12 Community Colleges in the states of Michigan including Henry Ford College, Dearborn, Jackson College, Grand Rapids Community College and Montcalm Community College in Michigan and Lone Star Colleges in Houston, Austin Community College, Alamo Colleges in San Antonio and South Texas College in McAllen in the state of Texas. In 2016, the Panwar Group of Institutions signed MoUs with Montcalm Community College, Sidney, Michigan, Alamo Colleges, San Antonio, South Texas College, McAllen and Dallas County Community College District in Texas for Study Abroad Student and Faculty Exchange Programs.

In May of 2017, the Panwar Group of Institutions hosted the first batch of Study Abroad Student & Faculty Exchange Program from the Montcalm Community College (MCC), a rural Community College in Michigan. We also organized an International Workshop on the topic "Community Colleges as Catalyst for Change in India" which was attended by academics, policy makers and representatives of educational institutions interested in establishing a Community College movement in India. This large-scale initiative was preceded by two

National Workshops on Community Colleges organized by the Panwar Group of Institutions in October 2015 and November 2016.

Additionally, in May 2017, M.S.Panwar Community & Technical College took the membership of National Institute of Staff & Organizational Development (NISOD) based in the University of Texas, Austin and Community Colleges for International Development (CCID) based in Lone Star Community Colleges, Houston. I participated and presented a paper in the Annual Convention of NISOD in Austin from May 27-30,2017. Thereafter, in June, 2017, I visited Ivy Tech Community College and University of Indiana, Columbus, Desmoine Area Community College, Kirkword Community College and Iowa State University, Ames in Iowa State in July,2017. I got an opportunity of visiting and networking with the School of Global Journalism & Communication of Morgan State University, Baltimore, Maryland through its Department of International Programs.
